OVERVIEW

The Green Microfinance Study Tour is a platform for knowledge exchange between practitioners eager to learn from the best practices and to share expertise in the field of green finance. It aims at creating awareness on green finance business opportunities, but also at sharing lessons learned and critical success factors with leading stakeholders involved in the sector, such as microfinance institutions (MFIs), Clean Energy Technologies (CET) providers and research institutions.

The training tour exposes participants to best practices in Bangladesh, one of the most advanced clean energy and green microfinance markets in the world.

The week consists of classroom training, field visits and workshops. The program's modular approach and flexible structure aims at allowing for customization with the particular learning wishes of each individual participant.
